NOTICE TO FEED INDUSTRY

CHANGE IN COMMERCIAL FEED LICENSE FEE

Effective July 1, 2008 the annual commercial feed license fee is three hundred dollars (\$300) for each location where commercial feed is manufactured, distributed, sold, or stored for later sale.

Per Section 15053 of the California Food and Agriculture Code, the Feed Inspection Advisory Board recommended to the Secretary of Agriculture, to set the annual feed license fee at three hundred dollars (\$300) for each location. As a result, the Office of Administrative Law promulgated the regulation and amended the Section 2751 of the California Code of Regulations to set the annual feed license fee at three hundred dollars (\$300) for each location operated.

All licenses shall be renewed on July 1 of each year and shall be valid until June 30 of the next year. Each application for renewal shall be accompanied by a fee in an amount of three hundred dollars (\$300) for each location. If a license is not renewed within one calendar month following its expiration, a penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100) will be added to the fee.
