Fertilizing Materials - Weights and Measures Standards

Dear Fertilizing Materials Licensee:

The Fertilizing Material Inspection Program (FMIP) makes every effort to ensure that fertilizing material labels appearing in the channels of trade in California are compliant with CDFA fertilizing material laws and regulations. FMIP is not responsible for enforcing labeling laws of other states and federal agencies. Occasionally labels for CDFA- FMIP registered products have been found to not be in compliance with other laws and regulations, such as the [California Division of Measurement Standards](#) or local [Weights & Measures office](#) . These requirements can be found in Title 4, Division 9, Chapter 10 of the California Code of Regulations, which you may locate at <https://www.cdfa.ca.gov/dms/publications.html> (Click on “Chapter 10: Quantity Control” under “REGULATIONS”). Ultimately, it is the firm’s responsibility to make sure that labels are compliant with other local, state, or federal agencies laws.
