

- Office is on the corner of Service and Crows Landing roads.


From South:

Is Director for the Office of Surveillance and Compliance at FDA’s Center for Veterinary Medicine in Rockville Maryland. Dr. McChesney has several years experience with the FDA and is an expert in the regulations of Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) and implantation of FSMA.

David Fairfield: Director of Feed Services, National Grain and Feed Association

Is Director of Feed Services at NGFA where he serves as staff liaison to the NGFA’s Feed Industry Committee addressing a wide range of legislative and regulatory issues affecting feed manufacturers. He also serves on several industry committees and provides assistance to State and Regional Grain and Feed Associations in addressing feed-related issues.

Who Should Attend:

The morning session is a great opportunity for Feed Industry leaders and management to discuss future regulations and policy regarding the Feed Safety Modernization Act signed into law in January of this year. This act will represent the most comprehensive regulatory requirements the Feed Industry has seen since the implementation of Current Good Manufacturing Practice Regulations.

The afternoon session is a labeling workshop designed for formulators and staff involved in producing feed labels. The workshop will include required guarantees, official ingredient names, required warning statements and feeding directions.
