## Silica Labeling Aid

- The minimum guarantee for silica or monosilicic acid is 0.0005% (5 ppm). If
  your product does not guarantee at least 0.0005% silica, you may not guarantee it
  or refer to silica on the product label, per Section 2300(j) of the California Code of
  Regulations (CCR).
- A laboratory analysis of the product's silica content must be submitted for every product which guarantees silica or monosilicic acid, to verify the label guarantee.
  - Please note, The AAPFCO method for Soluble Silicon (Si) is only acceptable for solid/dry products.
- Your silica guarantee should appear in one of the following formats:

X% Silicon Dioxide (SiO<sub>2</sub>) from [source]

or

X% Silica (SiO<sub>2</sub>) from [source]

or

## X% Monosilicic Acid

- If your product guarantees at least one plant nutrient, the silica guarantee should be listed under the heading "ALSO CONTAINS NONPLANT FOOD INGREDIENTS," as required by Section 2303(I) of the CCR.
- If the product is considered an Auxiliary Soil and Plant Substance (see Section 14513 of the Food and Agricultural Code), the silica guarantee should be located under the heading "NONPLANT FOOD INGREDIENT(S)."
  - Auxiliary Soil and Plant Substances which guarantee silica may not include directions for foliar application. Only soil application directions may be included on the product label.
