

Wetting Agents and Surfactants Labeling Aid

Use the following labeling formats if your fertilizing material includes a wetting agent, such as a surfactant or soil penetrant:

- If the wetting agent or surfactant is an ingredient of a **Beneficial Substance - Chemical/Biological**, the labeling should have the following format:

CONTAINS BENEFICIAL SUBSTANCE(S)

Polymers (state names of the specific polymers).....%

Wetting Agent (state name of the specific wetting agent)....%

- If the wetting agent or surfactant is an ingredient of a **Commercial Fertilizer, Specialty Fertilizer**, or **Agricultural Mineral**, the labeling should have the following format:

ALSO CONTAINS BENEFICIAL SUBSTANCE(S)

Polymers (*disclose specific name of polymers to CDFA – not required on the label*).....%

Wetting Agent (*disclose specific name of wetting agent to CDFA – not required on the label*).....%

- If the wetting agent is an ingredient of a Beneficial Substance - Physical, include the **Wetting Agent** in the ingredient list. Disclose the specific name of the wetting agent for CDFA records only. For example: “Ingredients: Coco coir, peat moss, perlite, wetting agent.”
