### PROSECUTION UPDATES

#### **Eric L. Hall & Eric R. Anderson dba Roadhouse Winery – Santa Rosa, CA**

On December 2, 2013, a civil complaint was filed against Roadhouse Winery for unfair business practices under the B & P Code 17200 (operating without a license).

Mr. Hall to pay retroactive license fees as a Processor, post a surety bond and pay a county fine.

In July 2014, Mr. Hall obtained a Processor's license, submitted a \$10,000 surety bond and submitted an application for a Weighmaster's license.

The final judgment and injunction imposed civil penalties in the amount of \$10,000 and retroactive fees in the amount of \$1,200. Mr. Hall is also prohibited for a period of three years from acting as a processor of grapes without a license as required by the Food and Agricultural Code section 55521; acting as a weighmaster without a license as required by the Business and Professions Code section 12703; purchasing grapes without having the grapes weighed by a licensed weighmaster; and from engaging in any unfair business practices. Mr. Hall is also required to maintain an irrevocable guarantee or surety bond until November 30, 2016.

#### **Janae and Frane Franicevic dba Sunce Winery – Santa Rosa, CA**

On May 14, 2014, a civil complaint was filed against Sunce Winery for unfair business practices under the B & P Code 17200 (operating without a license).

On July 10, 2014, Mr. Franicevic met with the Sonoma County DA, the matter is ongoing.

Deputy DA is writing the proposed settlement to present it to Sunce Winery in January 2015.
