

## 2020 Alternative manure management program

### Questions and answers (Q&A)

March 18, 2020

1. The previous AMMP applications allowed for the Project Narrative Template to be uploaded as a PDF file along with additional supporting documentation. Now that the Project Narrative Template must be uploaded as a Word Document, how do you submit additional supporting documents as PDF files?

“Section VII: Additional Information” has been added to the application so that applicants can upload any additional supporting documentation to support their application.
2. The Project Narrative Template opens with Track Changes enabled and alters the formatting of the template once typed. Will this affect the scoring?

No, scoring will not be affected. An applicant who has already completed the Project Narrative Template can (1) accept all changes and turn off track changes; (2) copy completed text, turn off track changes and paste text back into the same document; or (3) use the most recent Project Narrative Template that has been uploaded with track changes disabled to copy/paste from the existing template or start a new one.
3. Are there opportunities to demonstrate pre-commercial new technologies with AMMP funding?

No. AMMP Demonstration Projects-New Technologies and Practices (NTP) is not being offered at this time. Please continue to check the AMMP website and/or signup for our listserv to get information on future opportunities.
4. Selecting “NO” for the question pertaining to socially disadvantaged groups in the Applicant Information section of the application requires an applicant to still select a socially disadvantaged group in order to complete and submit the application.

This issue has been corrected. Applicants who do not belong to a socially disadvantaged group as described by the question can now select “NO” and will not need to do anything further for this question.
5. If an applicant is a limited partnership, do the financial documents of both individual partners need to be submitted?
