

CDFA Dairy Digester Research and Development Program (DDRDP) 2018 Community Outreach Resources

Background

Pursuant to requirements set forth in California Government Code Section 16428.86(a), (i.e. SB 859, Section 6), a project shall not receive funding through the DDRDP unless the applicant has demonstrated to CDFA that the applicant has done all of the following:

- Conducted outreach in areas that will potentially be adversely impacted by the proposed project.
- Determined potential adverse impacts of the project.
- Committed to measures to mitigate impacts.

CDFA shall review the applicant's analysis identifying potential adverse impacts of the proposed project when making awards.

Services Provided

CDFA is partnering with [UC Davis Extension – Collaboration Center](#) (the Center) to serve as a resource for potential DDRDP applicants to support community outreach efforts.

Applicants may contact the Center (information provided below) to schedule a telephone consultation with a UC Davis Community Engagement Specialist, or request assistance to conduct a community meeting. Requests must be submitted via email to mvolat@ucdavis.edu attn. UC Collaboration Center by **12:00 p.m. (noon) PST on January 5, 2018 5:00 p.m. PST on December 26, 2017** and must include the following information:

- Project Name(s)
- Dairy Operation Name(s) and Location(s)
- Developer Name(s)
- Request for:
 - Consultation (Y/N)
 - Conducting a Community Meeting (Y/N)

Consultations and meeting assistance will be available on a first-come-first serve basis and based on schedule and resource availability, for up to 10 meetings.

Please note: Additional assistance appointments in response to requests received by January 5, 2018, may be available on January 8 and January 9, 2018 between 11 a.m. and 4 p.m.

CDFA has limited resources and funds available for community outreach activities through the Center; and funds will be allocated to assist as many applicants/developers as possible. Based on the number of requests received and funding availability, each applicant/developer may be limited to assistance for one community meeting. In addition, assistance requests for meetings are encouraged to include more than one applicant.
