What is the Dairy Digester Research

and Development Program?

California Department of Food and Agriculture's Dairy Digester Research and Development Program (DDRDP) awards competitive grants to California dairy operations and digester developers for the implementation of dairy digesters that result in methane emission reductions on California dairies and minimize or mitigate adverse environmental impacts.

What is the history of the program?

DDRDP was established in 2015 as a voluntary incentive program seeking to reduce methane emissions coming from dairy sector. In 2016, Legislature enacted SB 1383 (Lara, Chapter 395, Statutes of 2016) which requires the State to further reduce methane emissions from dairy and livestock sectors, among other, to 40 percent below 2013 levels by 2030.

How is the program funded?

The DDRDP has received multiple rounds of funding through the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (part of California Climate Investments) as well as the State's General Fund to support the implementation of these projects which have a large impact of reducing methane emissions in dairy operations across the State.

How much funding has the program distributed?


Since 2014 the programs has awarded nearly \$227 million, with an additional \$489 million in matching funds to more than 140 projects.
