2021 Solicitation Funding and Duration





Funding Sources:

- □ Budget Act of 2021 75 Million
 - 50 Million from the California General Fund
 - □ 25 Million from CCI

Solicitation Duration:

- □HSP Incentives Program: November 1, 2021 February 25, 2022
 - ☐ First-come, first-serve; Competitive
- □HSP Demonstration Projects: November 1, 2021 December 31, 2022
 - ☐ Competitive award
- Grant (Project) Duration (tentative):
- □Late Summer/Fall 2022 August 1, 2025









Next Steps for HSP Incentives - Improvements

- OEFI conducted listening session / workshop with TAPs and CES Spring/Summer 2022 after the Solicitation
- HSP Team received good feedback for how to improve process
- Currently working on changes to streamline the application process and improve our webtools such as Comet Planner and RePlan
- Programmatic changes to take stakeholder feedback in consideration – will present full list at next meeting
 - Prioritizing stacked practices applications
 - Landownership/lease terms
 - Etc.
