Destination Bulk Citrus County Agricultural Commissioner's (CAC) Responsibilities Exhibit "II" April 6, 2016

- 1) Destination CAC shall monitor activities at receiving facilities in the following manner:
 - a) Monitor trapping and detection programs at receiving facilities. Two traps minimum per facility.
 - b) Monitor receiving facilities record keeping and certification tags.
 - c) Monitor receiving facilities training program.
 - d) Monitor proper use of compliance certificate tags.
 - e) Notify the origin CAC when a load is rejected.
 - f) Shall reject a load of bulk citrus that contains live glassy-winged sharpshooter (GWSS).
 - g) Shall place hold orders and seals on sweat rooms containing infested citrus shipments until additional mitigation measures to eliminate viable GWSS life stages are implemented by the receiver.
- 2) Destination CAC shall monitor compliance agreements with:
 - a) Growers and;
 - b) Packers
- 3) The CAC shall provide direction to receivers to ensure all management practices and mitigation measures are consistent with the California Department of Food and Agriculture's (CDFA) Statewide Pest Prevention Program Final Programmatic Environmental Impact Report.
