

# Help Stop Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter (GWSS) from Spreading

*This insect pest attacks hundreds of plants, many used in landscaping.*

## Handle GWSS host plant waste carefully:

- Crape myrtle
- Grapevines
- Citrus
- Arbutus
- Oleander
- Photinia
- Pittosporum
- Privet
- Other GWSS host material ([bit.ly/GWSS-Hosts](http://bit.ly/GWSS-Hosts)).



### Pruning or Removing Trees & Shrubs

#### Put green waste in one:

- Green waste bin
- On-site chip pile
- Local landfill



### Chipping Material

#### After chipping:

- Keep chips on site, or
- Take chips to the local landfill



### Moving Green Waste

#### When moving:

- Cover load with a tarp
- Process as soon as possible
