





Funding Research to Safeguard California Winegrapes

About the PD/GWSS Board:

- A joint winegrape grower and government-funded board established in 2001
- Advises the California Department of Food and Agriculture on using assessment funds
- Ensures industry dollars are spent wisely and productively to find solutions to designated winegrape pests and diseases

Research and Outreach at Work for You:

- Industry funds are invested in research and outreach to protect vineyards, prevent the spread of pests and diseases, and deliver practical and sustainable solutions
- \$43.5 million invested in PD and GWSS research since 2001
- \$14.2 million invested in research on other pests and diseases since 2010

PD/GWSS Winegrape Assessment and Referendum:

- An annual, value-based assessment on winegrapes that funds research and related activities for designated winegrape pests and diseases
- The PD/GWSS Referendum is conducted every five years and will take place again in Spring 2025

- European grapevine moth
- Grapevine fanleaf disease
