The undersigned certify that as of 1 July 2019, the internet websites of the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) are being designed, developed, maintained, and verified to be in compliance with California Government Code Sections 11546.7.(a), 7405, and 11135 accessibility requirements. However, the conversion of existing/legacy CDFCA websites to meet the accessibility requirements is only partially compliant, as identified in the following exceptions, and CDFCA entity is working diligently to achieve full compliance.

Exceptions:

1. Conversion of existing/legacy CDFCA responsible internet websites to be compliant to the above accessibility requirements is 95% complete; the remaining 5% shall be converted to meet the accessibility requirements by July 31, 2019.
2. Conversion of existing/legacy CDFCA responsible blog sites to be compliant to the above accessibility requirements is incomplete; blog sites shall be converted to meet the accessibility requirements by August 31, 2019.
3. Verification and validation of compliance to the above accessibility requirements for all CDFCA responsible internet websites and blogs is currently incomplete and shall be completed by September 30, 2019.
4. Conversion of CDFCA internet viewable and/or downloadable media content to be compliant with the above accessibility requirements is not complete; as media content converted to be compliant, current website available media shall be replaced with compliant versions. Should a compliant version of media content that has not yet been converted be required, please send an email to ServiceDesk@cdfa.ca.gov to request a compliant version.
