

Guide to Voluntarily Report By-products (Organic Waste) Diverted to Animal Feed

This voluntary section is for reporting any by-products* diverted from the licensed location to animal feed that is NOT subject to regular tonnage tax reporting. Participation helps the Commercial Feed Regulatory Program quantify tonnage of by-products diverted to animal feed. **This section is voluntary, and the tonnage reported is not subject to tonnage tax.**

How to Report Tonnage of By-products Diverted to Animal Feed

What is Organic Waste versus By-products?
“Organic waste” is a broad term used in SB 1383 to describe various discarded plant and animal material. Organic waste which is safe and suitable for use in animal feed are commonly considered “By-products”.

Include in Regular Tonnage Tax Reporting:

All tonnage of commercial feed*, including by-products, that is distributed to a consumer-buyer*(non-licensed end-user) in California, except unmixed whole grains and whole hay.

Include in NEW Voluntary Reporting Section:

Tonnage of by-products which originated within CA that are brought into your facility for further manufacturing/processing*, including:

Those used in the manufacture of mixed and formula feeds prior to distribution to the consumer-buyer.

Wet by-products that are dried at your facility (i.e., "shrink") prior to distribution to the consumer-buyer.

Non-taxable tonnage of by-products diverted to animal feed (the end-user), including:

Tonnage diverted out of state or country

Tonnage diverted to pet food

Tonnage fed to one's own animals

Tonnage donated or given away at no cost

Do NOT Report:

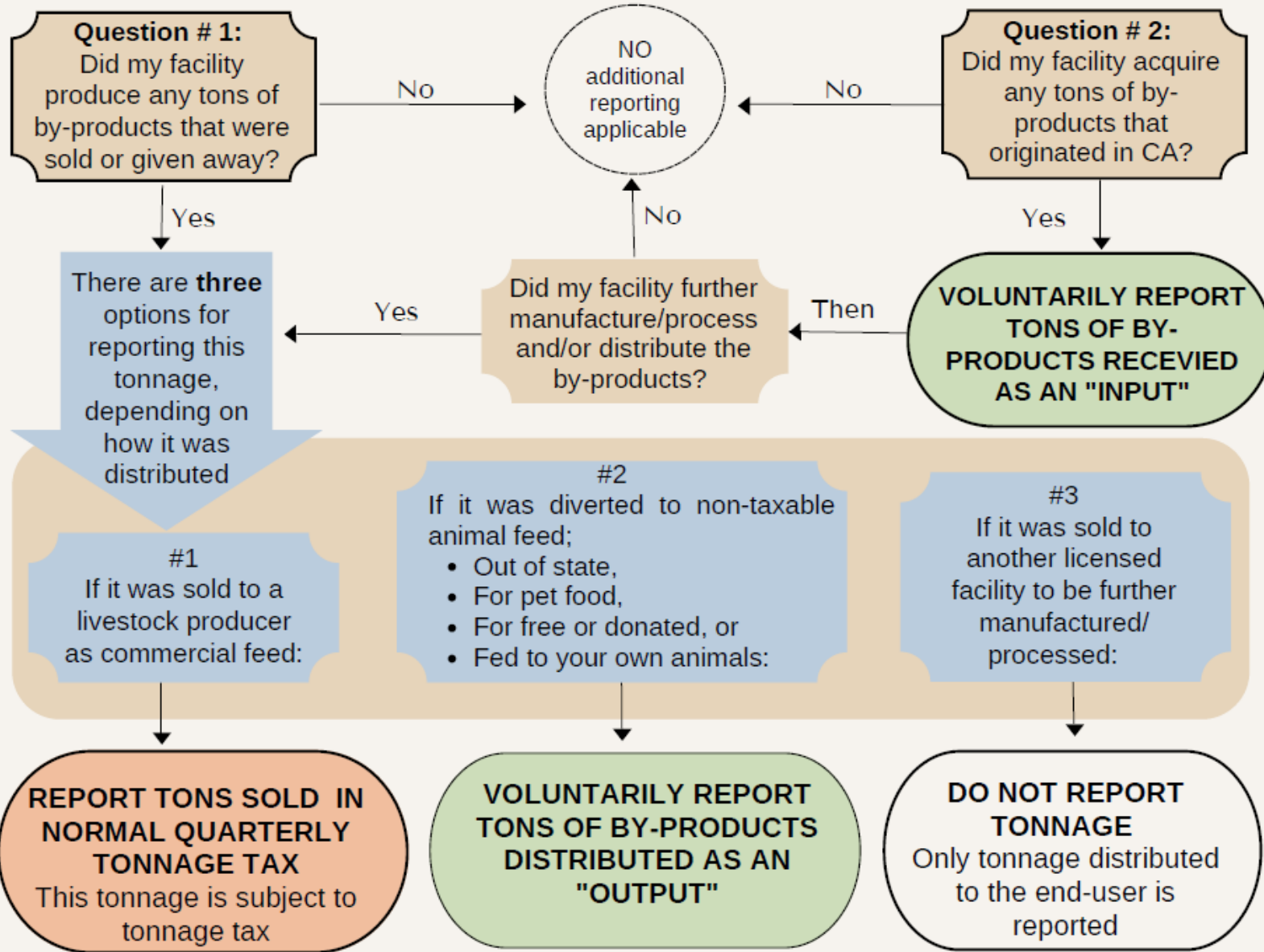
Tonnage diverted to another manufacturer (not the end-user).

Tonnage imported into California from another state or country.

Tonnage diverted to uses other than animal feed, such as fertilizer and compost.

HOW TO REPORT TONNAGE OF BY-PRODUCTS DIVERTED TO ANIMAL FEED



To voluntarily report by-products diverted to animal feed in ExtraView, follow the steps outlined below:

Step 1:

Select “YES” if you have any tonnage to voluntarily report based on the information provided above.

INPUT

Input is defined as the raw tonnage of by-products that originated within California that is brought into your facility and further processed to make animal feed.

- If incoming by-products are further processed (i.e. dried), use the **INPUT** entry to capture total diversion tonnage of raw incoming material (wet material tonnage).
- If incoming by-products are mixed with non-byproduct commodities (such as whole grains) in a formula feed, please report only **INPUT** of by-products used which originated in California. Do not report total tonnage of mixed feed.
 - Enter 0 if you have no tonnage for this section
 - When you have no tonnage for input, please choose the “0 Input – Not Applicable” option for City (Origin of Inputs)

City (Origin of Inputs)

“City (Origin of Inputs)” is the city or unincorporated area where the organic waste brought into your facility originated from.

- The dropdown lists all incorporated California cities by name and all unincorporated cities by county. If the organic waste’s city of origin is not included in the dropdown, choose the county the city is in with “Unincorporated” after it. (e.g., Alameda – Unincorporated).
- Choose “0 Inputs – Not Applicable” if you have no inputs to report

OUTPUT

Output is defined as the raw and/or processed tonnage of by-products that are outsourced from your facility to be used in animal feed. Use this section to report additional tonnage of by-products originating within California that was diverted (sold or distributed) to animal feed that is NOT already reported in your tonnage tax, including:

- Tonnage diverted out of state or country
 - Tonnage diverted to pet food
 - Tonnage fed to one's own animals
 - Tonnage donated or given away at no cost
- Enter 0 if you have no tonnage for this section

If by-products that are diverted by one of the abovementioned avenues are mixed with other commodities that are not by-products or did not originate from California prior to their distribution, do not report total tonnage of mixed feed as an output. You may report those by-products as an INPUT instead.

By-product Category

This section is to identify the type of by-products diverted to animal feed you are reporting. The four options are provided below with examples. Examples provided in the table below are not an inclusive list.

Use "By-product Category" to identify the type of by-product for each input/output you are reporting tonnage for. **See the list of by-products on page 6 to determine which by-product category to use.**

Use "By-product Notes" to identify the specific commodity for each input/output you are reporting.
