

Exhibit G2: Grower–Low-Risk Processing Tomato Field

1. Harvested tomato fruit from a low-risk processing tomato field shall only be transported by a transporter operating under a compliance agreement with the Broomrape Program.
2. Harvested tomato fruit from a low-risk processing tomato field shall only be transported to a processing facility operating under a compliance agreement with the Broomrape Program.
3. All persons authorized by Establishment to enter a low-risk processing tomato field shall be trained in broomrape identification and sanitation guidelines. See Broomrape Board recommended guidelines. ([Home | Broomrape](#))
4. All equipment authorized by Establishment to enter a low-risk processing tomato field shall be cleaned reasonably free of soil and plant debris prior to being transported out of a Designated Zone ([Designated Zone Map](#)). See Broomrape Board recommended guidelines for examples. ([Home | Broomrape](#))
5. Upon detection of a suspect broomrape plant, the Establishment shall immediately notify their contracted processor for that location. In the event the detection is outside of the Designated Zone, the Establishment shall also notify the Program immediately. ([Designated Zone Map](#))
6. In the event of a broomrape plant detection this exhibit is voided, and the Establishment shall operate under Exhibit G1.
