

Exhibit T1: Transporter–High-Risk Processing Tomato Field

1. Harvested tomato fruit shall only be transported from a high-risk processing tomato field if the grower is operating under a compliance agreement with the Broomrape Program.
2. Harvested tomato fruit shall only be transported from a high-risk processing tomato field if the processing facility is operating under a compliance agreement with the Broomrape Program.
3. All equipment shall be cleaned reasonably free of soil and plant debris, except MOT in a gondola, prior to moving from a high-risk processing tomato field. See Broomrape Board recommended guidelines for examples ([Home | Broomrape](#))
4. Trailers used to transport harvested tomato fruit from a high-risk processing tomato field shall be dedicated to that field. Once no longer needed in that field, they may return to the general trailer pool after the required cleaning.
5. Establishment shall use the most direct practicable route from a high-risk processing tomato field to the processing facility using appropriate trucking routes and avoiding unnecessary stops.
6. Trucks used to transport harvested tomato fruit from a high-risk processing tomato field shall be cleaned prior to exiting the processing facility. See Broomrape Board recommended guidelines ([Home | Broomrape](#))
7. Establishment shall require its subcontractors to operate in compliance with the requirements of this Exhibit.
