Program Update:

Statewide Cotton Seed Bug Survey

A statewide survey for the cotton pest *Oxycarenus hyalinipennis*, also known as the cotton seed bug (CSB) is currently underway. The survey includes visual inspection as well as sampling of a small number of bolls at 10% of the cotton acreage in each cotton growing county in California.

The survey began on September 1, 2021. One hundred and thirty-three (133) field surveys have been completed. The survey will continue in Southern California during the week of October 4th. Surveys have been completed in Tulare, Kern, Kings, Fresno, Merced, Madera, Glenn, Colusa, and Sutter counties.

All boll samples will be inspected by the California Department of Food and Agriculture.
