DECIDUOUS FRUITS AND NUTS

OBLIQUEBANDED LEAFROLLER - Choristoneura rosaceana - Larvae observed on peach (stems, branches) in the San Joaquin Valley District, in Turlock, Stanislaus County, by J. E. Lindgren on January 24 (det. by T. Eichlin, CDFA).

PRUNE LIMB BORER - Bondia comonana - Observed on almond in the San Joaquin Valley District, in Turlock, Stanislaus County. J. E. Lindgren observed larvae on stems and branches on January 24 (det. by T. Eichlin, CDFA).

PEAR PSYLLA - Psylla pyricola - In the Central Mountains and Foothill District, from Gold Hill, Placerville area in El Dorado County, E. P. Delfino reports a mass occurrence on pear, in an area approximately 2,000 acres. Large numbers of overwintering adults, also eggs on February 5.

OTHER TROPICAL AND SUBTROPICAL FRUITS

GREEN SHIELD SCALE - Pulvinaria psidii - Adults found in the Southern Coast District, in San Dimas, Los Angeles County on Ficus benjamina on January 30 by R. Orsburn on plants shipped from Hawaii (conf. by R. Gill, CDFA).
