

A veronicellid slug (*Veronicella cubensis*)

- ❑ Native to Cuba and intercepted from HI.
- ❑ Hosts: Usually found near water bodies or moist soil.
- ❑ Field ID: Adult about 50-70 mm long; mantle covers entire back of the animal, no shell, **breathing pore opens on underside of mantle behind foot**. Body oval, brown with a paler medio-dorsal line on dorsum of mantle.
