

Sycamore scale (*Stomacoccus platani*)

- ❑ Found outdoors throughout CA.
- ❑ Hosts: Sycamore trees (*Platanus* sp.).
- ❑ Field ID: Larva **cyst-shaped**, yellow, 1.5 mm in length; adult yellow, elongated, about 2 mm length. Larvae resemble eggs on underside of leaves, and adults resemble thrips, but they are easily identified by the **chlorotic or brown necrotic spots** that they cause on the leaves.
