

# Mulberry whitefly (*Tetraleurodes mori*)

- ❑ Common outdoors and in nurseries in CA, also in shipments from FL and TN.
- ❑ Hosts: Common on *Citrus* and Guava, also found on Bay laurel (*Laurus nobilis*), Mulberry (*Morus rubra*), California bay (*Umbellularia californica*), Ash (*Fraxinus* sp.), and chaparral plants.
- ❑ Field ID: ‘Pupa’ **shiny black**, about 1 mm long with **white fringe** of wax at least as wide as about half the width of pupa.
