

Amend the following:

§ 3289 Guava Root-Knot Nematode State Exterior Quarantine

A quarantine is established against the following pest, its hosts, and possible carriers:

(a) Pest. Guava root-knot nematode (*Meloidogyne enterolobii*, syn. *M. mayaguensis*).

(b) Area Under Quarantine. The states of Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, ~~and~~ North Carolina, and the Territory of Puerto Rico.
