

NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS, AND ADDITION OF DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION TO RULEMAKING FILE

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Food and Agriculture is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation CCR 3700, Oak Mortality Disease Control, originally noticed to the public in the California Regulatory Notice Register on March 13, 2026.

Additionally, pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8(d), 11346.9(a)(1), and 11347.1, The Department of Food and Agriculture is providing notice that a document and other information being incorporated by reference which the agency has relied upon in adopting the proposed regulations has been added to the rulemaking file and is available for public inspection and comment.
