

NOTICE OF MODIFICATIONS TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS, AND ADDITION OF
DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION TO RULEMAKING FILE

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Food and Agriculture is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation CCR 3060.3. Plants That Are Pests., originally noticed to the public in the California Regulatory Notice Register on February 13, 2026.
