

Amend the following:

§ 3060.3. Plants That Are Pests.

A plant that is a pest does not meet the standards of cleanliness contained in Section 3060.2 and may not be produced, held or offered for sale as nursery stock. Plant pests include:

- (a) All plants defined as a noxious weed under Title 3, California Code of Regulations, Section 4500 ~~are a pest plant., and~~
- (b) All plants rated A or B under Title 3, California Code of Regulations, Section 3162.
