

In Title 3, Division 4, Chapter 3, amend Section 3434 to read:

**Section 3434. Light Brown Apple Moth Interior Quarantine.**

A quarantine is established against the following pest, its hosts and possible carriers.

(a) Pest. Light brown apple moth (*Epiphyas postvittana*),

(b) Area Under Quarantine.

(2) In the County of Orange, in the Huntington Beach area: Beginning at the intersection of Beach Boulevard and Ellis Avenue; then, easterly along Ellis Avenue to its intersection with Brookhurst Street; then, northerly along said street to its intersection with Talbert Avenue; then, easterly along said avenue to its intersection with W MacArthur Boulevard; then, starting easterly along said boulevard to its intersection with S Fairview Street; then, southerly along said street to its intersection with Fairview Road; then, southerly along said road to its intersection with US Interstate 405 N and State Highway 73 S; then, starting easterly along said highway to its intersection with State Highway 55 S; then, southwesterly along said highway to its intersection with Victoria Street; then, northwesterly along said street to its intersection with Harbor Boulevard; then, southerly along said boulevard to its intersection with Newport Boulevard; then, starting southwesterly along said boulevard to its intersection with State Highway 1; then, northwesterly along said highway to its intersection with Beach Boulevard; then, northerly along said boulevard to the point of beginning.
