§ 3436. Bactrocera albistrigata Interior Quarantine.

A quarantine is established against the following pest, its hosts and possible carriers. (a) Pest. White striped fruit fly, *Bactrocera albistrigata*.

(b) Area Under Quarantine. [Reserved]

(c) Articles and Commodities Covered. The following are declared to be hosts and possible carriers of white striped fruit fly.

(1) All fruit, vegetables or berries of <u>the plants listed in CCR 3591.23</u> (b) White Striped <u>Fruit Fly Eradication Area</u>, the following:

§ 3591.23. White Striped Fruit Fly Eradication Area.

(a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. That portion of the State of California described as follows, within which the white striped fruit fly, *Bactrocera albistrigata*, is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to be an eradication area with respect to said pest.
