§ 3591.12. Peach Fruit Fly Eradication Area.

- (a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. That portion of the State of California described as follows, within which peach fruit fly, *Bactrocera zonata*, is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to be an eradication area with respect to said pest, and as such, it is amenable to the provisions of Article 4 (Sections 5761, 5762, 5763 and 5764) of Chapter 8, Part 1, Division 4, of the Food and Agricultural Code of California.
