

In Title 3, Division 4, Chapter 3, amend, Section 3591.20 to read:

Section 3591.20 Light Brown Apple Moth Eradication Area.

(a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. Those portions of the State of California described as follows within which a certain pest, light brown apple moth (*Epiphyas postvittana*), is known to exist are hereby proclaimed to be eradication areas with respect to said pest:

The entire counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Los Angeles, Marin, Monterey, Napa, Sacramento, San Benito, San Francisco, San Joaquin, San Luis Obispo, San Mateo, Santa Barbara, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, Ventura and Yolo.
