(a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. That portion of the State of California described as follows, within which black fig fly, (*Silba adipata* McAlpine) is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to be an eradication area with respect to said pest, and as such, is amenable to the provisions of Article 4 (Sections 5761, 5762, 5763 and 5764) of Chapter 8, Part 1, Division 4, of the Food and Agricultural Code of California.

(1) Eradication Area. The entire counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino, <u>San Diego, San Luis Obispo,</u> Santa Barbara, and Ventura.
