Amend the following section:

Section 3591.2. Oriental Fruit Fly Eradication Area.

(a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. That portion of the State of California described as follows, within which there is a high risk of introduction of the Oriental fruit fly, *Bactrocera dorsalis*, is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to be an eradication area with respect to said pest, and as such it is amenable to the provisions of Article 4 (Sections 5761-, 5762, 5763, and 5764) of Chapter 8, Part 1, Division 4, of the Food and Agricultural Code of California. The entire counties of Alameda, <u>Butte, Colusa</u>, Contra Costa, El Dorado, <u>Humboldt, Imperial</u>, Los Angeles, <u>Marin, Merced, Monterey, Napa, Nevada</u>, Orange, <u>Placer</u>, Riverside, Sacramento, San Bernardino, San Diego, <u>San Francisco</u>, San Joaquin, San Mateo, Santa Barbara, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Shasta, <u>Solano</u>, Sonoma, Stanislaus, Sutter, Ventura, <u>Yuba</u>, and Yolo.
