Amend the following:

§ 3591.6. Spongy Moth Eradication Area.

- (a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. That portion of the State of California described as follows, within which spongy moth, *Lymantria dispar*, is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to be an eradication area with respect to said pest, and as such is amenable to the provisions of Article 4 (Sections 5761, 5762, and 5763) of Chapter 8, Part 1, Division 4, of the Food and Agricultural Code of California.
- (1) The entire counties of <u>Alameda, Butte</u>, Los Angeles, Marin, Nevada, Orange, Riverside, San Diego, San Mateo, Santa Barbara, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz and Ventura.
