Amend Section 3591.13(a) to read:

 (a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. That portion of the State of California described as follows, within which a certain pest, guava fruit fly (*Bactrocera correcta*), is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to be an eradication area with respect to said pest: The entire counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, <u>El Dorado</u>, Los Angeles, Orange, <u>Placer</u>, Riverside, Sacramento, San Bernardino, San Diego, Santa Clara, and Ventura.
