In Title 3, Division 4, Chapter 3, amend, Section 3591.20 to read:

## Section 3591.20 Light Brown Apple Moth Eradication Area.

(a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. Those portions of the State of California described as follows within which a certain pest, light brown apple moth (*Epiphyas postvittana*), is known to exist are hereby proclaimed to be eradication areas with respect to said pest:

The entire counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Los Angeles, Marin, Monterey, Napa, San Benito, San Francisco, <u>San Joaquin,</u> San Mateo, Santa Barbara, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Solano, Sonoma, Ventura and Yolo.
