Amend Section 3591.12(a) to read:

(a) Proclamation of Eradication Area. That portion of the State of California described as

follows, within which peach fruit fly, Bactrocera zonata, is known to exist, is hereby proclaimed to

be an eradication area with respect to said pest, and as such, it is amenable to the provisions of

Article 4 (Sections 5761-, 5762, 5763 and 5764) of Chapter 8, Part 1, Division 4, of the Food and

Agricultural Code of California.

(4) The entire county of Napa.
