

Amend Section 3700 Oak Mortality Disease Control to read:

§ 3700. Oak Mortality Disease Control.

Restrictions are hereby established against the following pest, its hosts, and possible carriers.

(a) Pest. A fungus, *Phytophthora ramorum*, which causes oak mortality disease (sudden oak death).

(b) Regulated Area. The regulated area for the pest is: The entire counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Del Norte, Humboldt, Lake, Marin, Mendocino, Monterey, Napa, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, San Francisco, Solano, Sonoma and Trinity.
