**Notice of Changes to Text of Proposed Regulations**

**March 9, 2023**

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8 (c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Food and Agriculture is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation section Title 3 California Code of Regulations (CCR) Sections 4890, 4900, 4901, 4902, 4930, 4934, 4935, 4936, 4940, 4941, 4942, 4943, 4944, 4946, 4950, 4950.1, 4951, and 4952, pertaining to the Industrial Hemp. The proposed regulation's public comment period was open between November 4, 2022 and December 19, 2022.
