UPDATE ON THE HARVEST DEFINITION

We recommend the following definition:

(a)(13)(1) "Harvest" means the collection of any portion of an industrial hemp plant at the termination of the cultivation process for the purpose of processing, distribution, storage, or sale.

(2) "Harvest" excludes vegetative growth and does not include material removed from the plant for:

- A. testing, that is not followed by the processing of the material for the purposes in (a)(13)(1)
- B. research and development, that is not followed by the processing of the material for the purposes in (a)(13)(1)
- C. thinning,
- D. cloning of vegetative growth
 - a. Only cloning of vegetative material is authorized without harvest reporting
- *E. tissue propagation of vegetative growth*
 - a. Only tissue propagation of vegetative material is authorized without harvest reporting
- F. male culling,
- G. disposal,
- H. transplants from one lot to another lot if both lots are within the same permit holder's control.
