**Pink Bollworm Activities**

**Southern California:**

There have been no native Pink Bollworm (PBW) captures to date. The last native PBW capture (1) was trapped in 2011. There are no sterile releases over cotton this year in California, Arizona, and Mexico.

**San Joaquin Valley:**

Trap deployment is nearly completed in San Joaquin Valley cotton. To date, trappers have placed 567 general detection traps in Kern County, 655 in Kings County, 209 in Tulare County, 594 in Fresno County, 643 in Merced County and 23 in Madera County. The number of traps in each county is subject to change as cotton acreage is verified.

**Sacramento Valley:**

The latest heat unit projections indicate trapping deployment will begin in late August or early September.
