

CDFA ANNOUNCES VACANCY ON  
THE CALIFORNIA COTTON PEST CONTROL BOARD

SACRAMENTO, May 19, 2017 - The California Department of Food and Agriculture's Integrated Pest Control Branch is announcing a vacancy on the California Cotton Pest Control Board. This advisory Board makes recommendations to the CDFA Secretary on all matters pertaining to the Pink Bollworm Control Program.

The term of office for a Board Member is unlimited. The Members receive no compensation, but are entitled to payment of necessary traveling expenses in accordance with the rules of the Department of Personnel Administration. Members are considered public officials and must be willing to comply with necessary disclosure requirements.

The vacancy is for a Madera, Merced, or Tulare County cotton grower representative.
