**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
CONCERNING PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND AGRICULTURE**

Pertaining to the Asian Citrus Psyllid Interior Quarantine

Notice was properly mailed on April 26, 2018 and published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on April 27, 2018, that the Department of Food and Agriculture proposes to in Division 4, Chapter 3, Subchapter 4, amend Article 4, Sections 3435 of the regulations in Title 3 of the California Code of Regulations pertaining to Asian Citrus Psyllid Interior Quarantine.

A public hearing concerning the proposed action will be held promptly on Monday, June 18, 2018, at 3:00 P.M., at the CDFA Auditorium, First Floor, Sacramento County Department of Agriculture Building, 1220 N Street, Sacramento, California.

A representative of the Department of Food and Agriculture will preside over the hearing. Any interested person, or his or her duly authorized representative, may appear and be heard. Persons who speak are requested to register prior to the hearing. The prehearing registration with a sign in sheet with names and affiliation, and a speakers list will be available at the location of the hearing from 2:30 p.m. to 3:00 P.M. Registered persons will be heard in the order of their registration. Any other person who wishes to speak at the hearing will be afforded such opportunity after the registered persons have been heard. The hearing will continue until there are no persons present to address the Department or until 5:00 P.M.

The Department is specifically requesting that in consideration of others, all persons attending the hearing refrain from wearing perfumes, colognes, or other scented personal care products.

If the number of preregistered persons and other participants in attendance at the hearing warrants it, the presiding officer may limit the time for each presentation in order to allow everyone wishing to speak the opportunity to be heard.

Any person, or his or her duly authorized representative who does not wish to speak at the hearing may present written statements to the presiding officer at the hearing, or may submit written statements on or before June 18, 2018 to the agency officer named below. Following the public hearing and the written comment period, the Department of Food and Agriculture, at its own motion, or at the instance of any interested person, may amend the proposal substantially as set forth with the required notice.
