To: Participants – Strawberry Registration and Certification Program

Subject: Virus Indexing Fee Increase

Participation in the California Strawberry Nursery Stock Registration and Certification Program is voluntary. Participants in the Program are required to complete virus indexing for applicable Foundation Block clone material. Additional mother plants may be submitted as service samples for indexing by the Department.

Starting with the 2022 season, the annual fee for registration of Foundation Blocks will be increased to \$1,650 for each planting, plus \$100 for each additional plant indexed in excess of 30. The cost of service sampling will be \$110 for each mother plant index tested.

The Strawberry Registration and Certification Program is currently operating at a deficit and the updated fee structure is necessary to keep the program solvent. Increases in personnel and operating costs of the greenhouse facilities have increased beyond the revenues collected. CDFA will continue to monitor program expenditures and revenues to ensure that the program operates at cost.
