# CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

#### **UPDATE ON THE BOARD'S MOTION REGARDING FAC § 242**

Arima Kozina, CDFA Deputy Secretary of Administration and Finance, provided a brief update regarding FAC § 242. Kozina indicated that the Nursery Services Program was paying 7.4% in indirect costs at this time. The Department was working on updating its policy pertaining to indirect costs.

#### PRIOR MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL

Kister directed the Board to review the draft minutes prepared by the program staff for the May 16, 2023 meeting. A copy of the draft minutes had been distributed to the Board members and posted on the Department's website prior to the meetings. Kister opened the floor for any changes or corrections. The Board reviewed minutes from September 9, 2021, December 14, 2021, November 29, 2022 and December 29, 2022. For the November 29, 2022 minutes, a correction was requested to note the Board's concern that the Arizona shipping requirements were not brought to the Board sooner. # ARIZONA SHIPPING REQUIREMENTS UPDATE AND DISCUSSION

Joshua Kress reviewed Arizona rule R3-4-203. Kress shared a draft Compliance Agreement for AZDA and CDFA Origin Inspection (Agreement No. 2023-03 – Nursery Stock) and asked the Board for feedback. Kress also discussed conducting training and outreach in coordination with AZDA.

# **NURSERY SERVICES PROGRAM UPDATE**

Kristina Weber provided several updates regarding the Nursery Services Program. San Diego and Riverside Counties were moving forward with the Systems Approach to Nursery Certification (SANC) program. CDFA was facilitating discussions with National Plant Board and the county agricultural commissioners to resolve questions regarding implementation of SANC.

Nursery Services was working on an analysis to determine if program fees (licensing and registration and certification programs) were covering operational costs.

Nursery Services staff were reviewing and updating standard operating procedures to ensure services were provided in a timely manner.

The Nominating Committee reviewed Jessica Fernandez's application for appointment to the Board and recommended her appointment.
