CDFA PROGRAM UPDATES

- National Honey Bee Survey FY23 sampling is complete. Surveys will begin this fall and next spring for FY24. Training will be provided to interested counties during sampling.
- County Contracts Task Force meeting was held on August 13, 2024. Future meetings will be scheduled and posted online.
- Registration fee update currently in review with the Legal office at CDFA.
- Apiary Pre-Inspection Program (APIP) Incoming bee shipments should start around September. CDFA will travel to Montana, Utah, and audit North Dakota for pre-inspection of hives prior to transport into California.

CACASA UPDATE: APIARY

Marcie Skelton provided the California Agricultural Commissioners and Sealers Association, Apiary update. Fieldwatch maintenance fees have been paid in the past by the California Pest Control Advisers (CAPCA). CAPCA is looking for another group to pay the \$6500 maintenance fee in the future. The maintenance fees are paid in other states by university groups, similar to the UC Extension, and by state agencies. Discussion at CACASA for input if DPR, CDFA, or an industry group should pick up this fee. Requesting to have a CDFA representative at Nursery, Seed, and Apiary Committee to provide an Apiary update at the CACASA Fall Conference in Sacramento.

RURAL CRIMES TASK FORCE UPDATE

Deputy Freeman provided the Rural Crimes Task Force update with the number of hives that were reported as stolen in California. 3,000 hive thefts have occurred this year, almost half have been recovered. Deputy Freeman will provide a letter requesting CDFA involvement with hive theft.

BOARD MEMBER VACANCIES

Three board positions are currently open. Two names were previously presented for board positions; however, no information has been received by CDFA from either individual. Jackie Park-Burris was nominated by the board, CDFA will reach out to confirm interest.
