CITRUS

CITRICOLA SCALE - Coccus pseudomagnoliarum - Observed in the San Joaquin Valley District, in Seville, on January 24, by Bob Chilton and J. Gobin, on citrus. An average of five adults per leaf were counted (det. by Ray Gill, CDFA).

OTHER TROPICAL AND SUB-TROPICAL FRUITS

OLEANDER SCALE - Aspidiotus nerii - Adults found in the Low Desert District, in Redlands, San Bernardino County, by Arnold Wright on January 23, on bark and fruit of kiwi plant (det. by Ray Gill, CDFA).

FOREST AND SHADE TREES

GYPSY MOTH - Lymantria dispar - One male reported found in trap in the Central Coast and Delta District, Santa Cruz County, by R. Bingham, State Entomologist. The trap removed from field location into storage on September 5, 1979, and rechecked on January 24, when the specimen was found (det. confirmed by Ron Somerby, CDFA).

MAN AND ANIMAL

WINTER CRANEFLY - Trichocera annulata - San Joaquin Valley District, Bellota, San Joaquin County: "Very high count from blacklight trap, January 27. For past month Mosquito Abatement District receiving complaints from people thinking they are mosquitoes" (K.W. Brown).

PERENNIAL PEPPERCRESS - Lepidium latifolium - NEW TOWNSHIP RECORD - San Joaquin Valley District, Kings County, one mile east of Hanford, Collected on December 14, 1979, by Jerome Dunicliff (det. by Doug Barbe, CDFA).
