

Amber snail

(*Succinea* spp.)

- ❑ Native to CA and intercepted from HI and FL. Complex of species very difficult to identify (differences found in inner structures).
- ❑ Hosts: Usually found near water bodies or moist soil.
- ❑ Field ID: Adults about 10 mm long; shell very thin, **amber-colored**, with a **very large aperture** (longer than remaining of shell).
