


Cycad scale (*Furchadaspis zamiae*)

- ❑ Common in CA; also intercepted in shipments from HI.
- ❑ Hosts: Sago palms (*Cycas* and *Zamia*), also occasionally found on *Phoenix roebelenii*; *Kentia*; Bird of paradise (*Strelitzia*); *Musa* (Banana); *Aralia* and *Tachycarpus*.
- ❑ Field ID: Adult female 1.0-2.5 mm long; scale cover **oval, whitish** with **marginal yellowish exuvia**; covered with **threads of whitish wax**; body yellow, hidden by **ventral scale**. No males known.
